- The Campus Recreation Leadership Training program is undergoing a minor revision for Fall 2022
- The Director General presented the draft for the government mandated Quality Assurance Audit for the college
- The interim Academic Dean discussed upcoming and ongoing program revisions (Electronics Engineering Technology, Business Administration programs to be implemented in two to four years)
- The Fall 2021 Day Division applications show an overall increase of sixteen percent compared to the previous year, with many programs experiencing a steep increase in applications.
- DSU Chairperson Kevin Contant-Holowatyj presented a resolution to increase the number of student senators from four to nine (an increase from ten to twenty percent of student representation on the college senate).
